Movement Responds to Ongoing Technological Challenges and Member Privacy Concerns

In light of recent and ongoing technological disruptions, we, #ReclaimSA Youth Movement, are issuing this urgent advisory to all participants, supporters, and stakeholders involved in our communications platforms.

We have identified potential vulnerabilities across several of our digital channels. As a precautionary measure, we strongly advise all members to safeguard their personal information. This includes refraining from using real names, identifiable profile pictures, or any personally identifiable information on public or semi-public platforms such as Discord or other group communication tools.

Member Safety First

This advisory is not simply procedural: it is a fundamental aspect of our risk management strategy. The safety and privacy of our members remain our highest priority. We remind all participants that the internet is not a secure space, and it is crucial to remain vigilant, not just within our channels, but in all digital interactions.

On Government Awareness and Inaction

Individuals within government structures may be aware of our movement. We affirm our belief that silence in the face of injustice is complicity. However, we remain committed to peaceful advocacy, civic engagement, and the lawful expression of democratic rights. Any attempts to suppress or silence our voices only affirm the necessity of our mission.

Legal Standing and Public Relations Measures

As an organisation committed to lawful activism, we affirm that all internal communications and actions are carried out in accordance with legal frameworks governing freedom of expression, association, and privacy. Our Risk Management and Legal Advisory Teams are actively engaged in ensuring the protection of all members from targeted surveillance, harassment, or legal reprisal.

We have established public relations protocols and legal response mechanisms to support any individual who may be subject to undue pressure or unlawful action in relation to their



involvement in the movement. If you feel unsafe or targeted, we urge you to contact our Risk Management Unit immediately.

We are united.
We are informed.
We will not be intimidated into silence.
